THE NJATC APTITUDE TEST

Consists of 2 sections: Algebra and Functions, and Reading Comprehension. It will take approximately 2.5 hours to complete the 2-part test. The test is scored on a stanine scale of 1 to 9 with 5 as average. In accordance with the NJATC policy, an applicant can only test once every **3 months**. You are encouraged to prepare for this test with basic review of algebraic functions and with attention to your comprehensive reading skills.

Reading Comprehension: To study for the reading portion of the test, it is recommended that you read information and have the ability to recall what you have read either by answering questions or having someone quiz your memory.

Algebra and Functions: To study for the math portion of the test, it is recommended that you review Algebra 1 only. There are a variety of study materials on the Internet for additional practice.

Required Score for Apprenticeships: Lineman 5 / Estimator 6 / Meterman 7
