ABOUT THE PROGRAM

As a NW Line JATC apprentice, you will build, repair, and maintain the powerlines that carry electricity to homes and businesses across our communities. Linemen are responsible for the work on powerlines and overhead structures ranging upwards of 300 feet to underground vaults and trenches. Work can be in rural or metropolitan areas.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Completed online application
- Valid Commercial Driver's License (Class A with no E restriction)
- Current First Aid/CPR certification. Online cards are not accepted.
- Traffic Control Flagging Card (Issued in OR, WA, ID, or MT). Online cards are not accepted.
- Official high school transcript or equivalent (GED/HSED)
- 18 or older
- After completing the online application, applicants are scheduled for the NJATC Aptitude test and must score a 3 or higher to move on to the interview round.

INTERVIEW PROCESS

- Interviews are held every other month beginning in January.
- Applicants will be interviewed before our Committee.
- Once the interview is complete, applicants will be added to our Rank List.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Tree trimmers provide tree maintenance and removal near active power lines, often working in excess of 100 feet, utilizing ropes and aerial lifts to perform their job duties. Advanced rigging, cutting, and climbing techniques provide a safe working environment and assist in identifying trees that pose a danger.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Completed online application
- High School Transcript/Diploma or equivalent (GED/HSED)
- Valid Driver's License, 18 years or older
- First Aid/CPR card and Flagging Traffic Control card
- Must be able to obtain a Commercial Drivers License/Permit

VOLTA is a private, non-profit vocational training school, preparing students for entry-level work in the outside line industry.

Our program focuses on skills for entry-level linework. You will be taught by Journey-level instructors who are currently active in the industry.
